

● Survival Japanese - # 3 - Reserving Accommodation

If you're planning to do any travel outside of major cities during your time in Japan, it will definitely be to your advantage to remember a few phrases for use at hotels and ryokans. The following should help you get by when reserving accommodation.

■ Are there any rooms available?  
Heya wa aite imasu ka?

+++++  
■ Do you have a room available for two nights from June 13?  
Roku gatsu ju-san nichi kara ni haku, heya wa aite imasu ka?

■ I'd like a single (double/twin) room.  
Shinguru (daburu/tsein) wo onegaishimasu.

+++++  
■ We'd like to stay two nights.  
Ni haku tomaritai no desuga.

+++++  
■ Yes, there is a room available.  
Hai. Aiteiru heya wa gozaimasu.

+++++  
■ Unfortunately, there are no rooms available.  
Moshi-wake gozai-masen man-shitsu de gozaimasu.

+++++  
■ I would like to make a reservation.  
Yoyaku onegaishimasu.

■ I have a reservation. My name is \_\_\_\_.  
Yoyaku ga arimasu. Namae wa \_\_\_\_ desu.

■ What time is check in / check out?  
Chekkuin / Chekku au-to wa nanji desu ka?

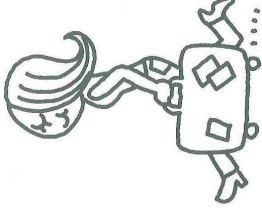

Mo ippaku tomaritai no desuga.

■ I'd like to check in / check out.  
Chekkuin / Chekku au-to onegaishimasu.

■ What is the room rate?  
Ippaku wa ikura desu ka?

■ How will you be paying?  
O-shi-harai wa do nasai-masu-ka?

■ I will pay (by credit card / with cash).  
Kurejitto ka-do / genkin de haraimasu.
