

## ● Survival Japanese - # 4 - At the ATM / Cash Machine

Most large nationwide banks have an English option, but only offer a very limited choice of services. Most smaller regional banks do not. ATMs can be used for a lot more things than just withdrawing cash. Use our guide to get a grip with the “other” buttons on the ATM screen and become an ATM whizz. Please be aware that terms for common functions vary from bank to bank.
