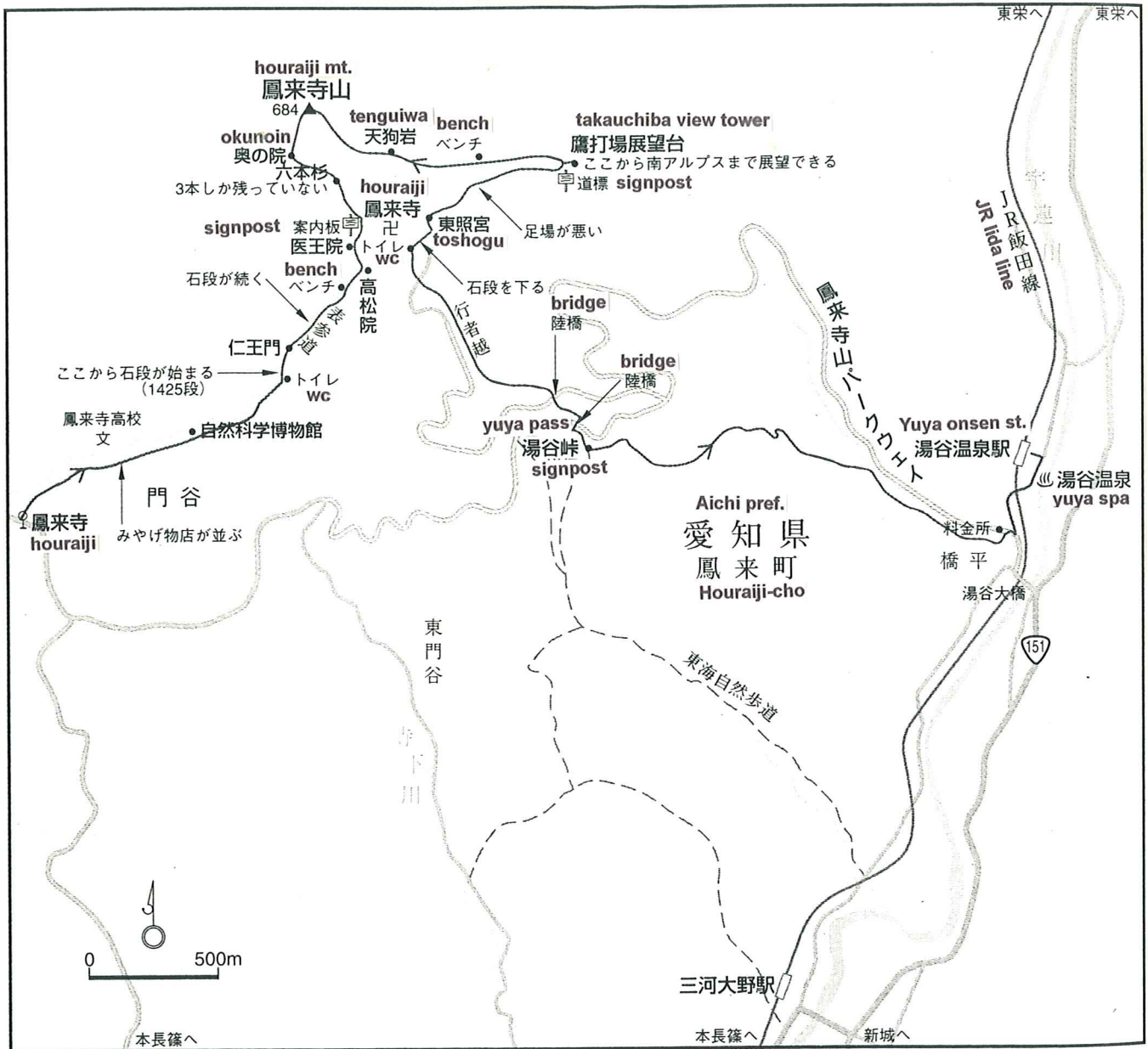

鳳来寺山

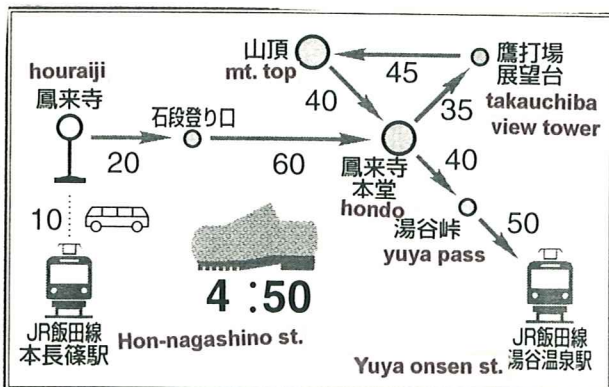


With Fine Views of Natural Monuments

Mt. Horaiji is situated in the east of Aichi prefecture, and the mountain itself is designated as a National Natural Monument. It is also at the skirt of an inactive volcano belt.

The whole area is covered with enormous Japanese cedars and, near the top of the mountain, an unexpected view of precipitous cliffs as well as bizarre rocks will surprise travelers.

The Takauchiba Tower will give you a superb view of the parkway below, leading to Yuya (where you can enjoy a hot spa if you have time) as well as the southern part of the South Alps.



[Access] Take the JR train from Nagoya to Toyohashi (Tokaido line) (50 min), then take the JR Iida line to Hon-Nagashino (55 min); then take a Toyotetsu Bus to Horaiji (25 min).

[Return] Take the JR Iida line train from the Yuya Spa to Toyohashi (1 hour 5 min), then take the faster Tokaido local train to Nagoya (50 min)

[Fare] About ¥4000.-
