



Shizugatake

Shizugatake is a mountain, 422m high, situated between Lake Biwa and Yogonoumi, and is designated as one of the eight most beautiful scenery spots around Lake Biwa. It is also known as an ancient battle field, where Hashiba (Toyotomi) Hideyoshi and Shibata Katsuie fought a battle over the control of the whole country after Oda Nobunaga was killed. From the top of the mountain, known as the Shizugatake Summit Park, you can see the beautiful scenery of Yogonoumi as well as of the northern part of Lake Biwa.

- [Access]** It takes about 30 min from JR Nagoya to Maibara (Tokaido Shinkansen), then take the JR Hokuriku Honsen to Yogo (30 min)
- [Return]** Iinoura-mae(Omi Bus) to Kinomoto, then take the JR Hokuriku Honsen to Maibara, then change for JR Nagoya station. **[Fare]** About ¥8100.-
