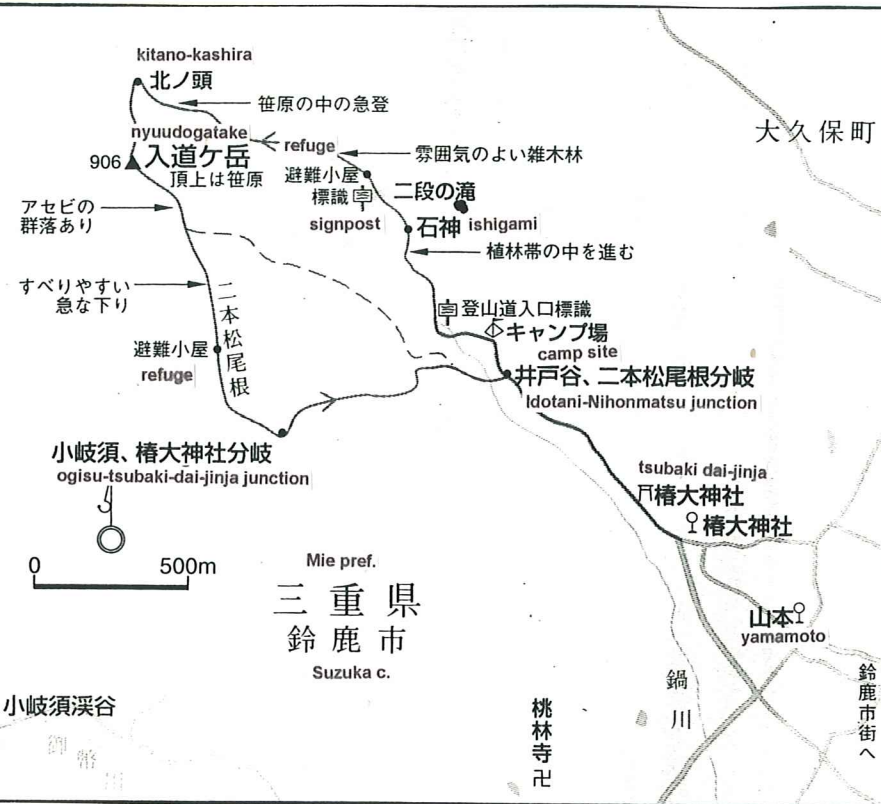


29 NYUDOGATAKE AND IDOTANI

Nyudogatake

Nyudogatake is situated to the south of Gozaishodake and Kamakuradake and is shaped like a rounded bonze's head, as its name suggests. It is also off the main mountains of Suzuka and projects far into the Ise plain, so the view from the top is grand in scale. Recently the top of the mountain is often used as a base for paragliders.

There are 6 climbing courses running down like the spokes of a wheel from the top. This time we'll introduce the course starting from Tsubaki Daijinja, descending the Nihonmatsu ridgeway by way of Idotani.

The top of the mountain is vast with a fine view. To the north, Kamagatake, to the south, Sengatake and to the east, Ise Bay across the Ise Plain

When going down the mountain, take the Nihonmatsu ridgeway. Descend the steep route with the help of the rope provided. After crossing many small valleys, you will reach the end of the course, Tsubaki Daijinja bus stop.

[Access] Kintetsu Nagoya Line Nagoya to Yokkaichi (30 min.), then the Sanko Bus to Tsubaki Daijinja (50 min) **[Return]** Take the same course in reverse **[Fare]** About ¥3300
