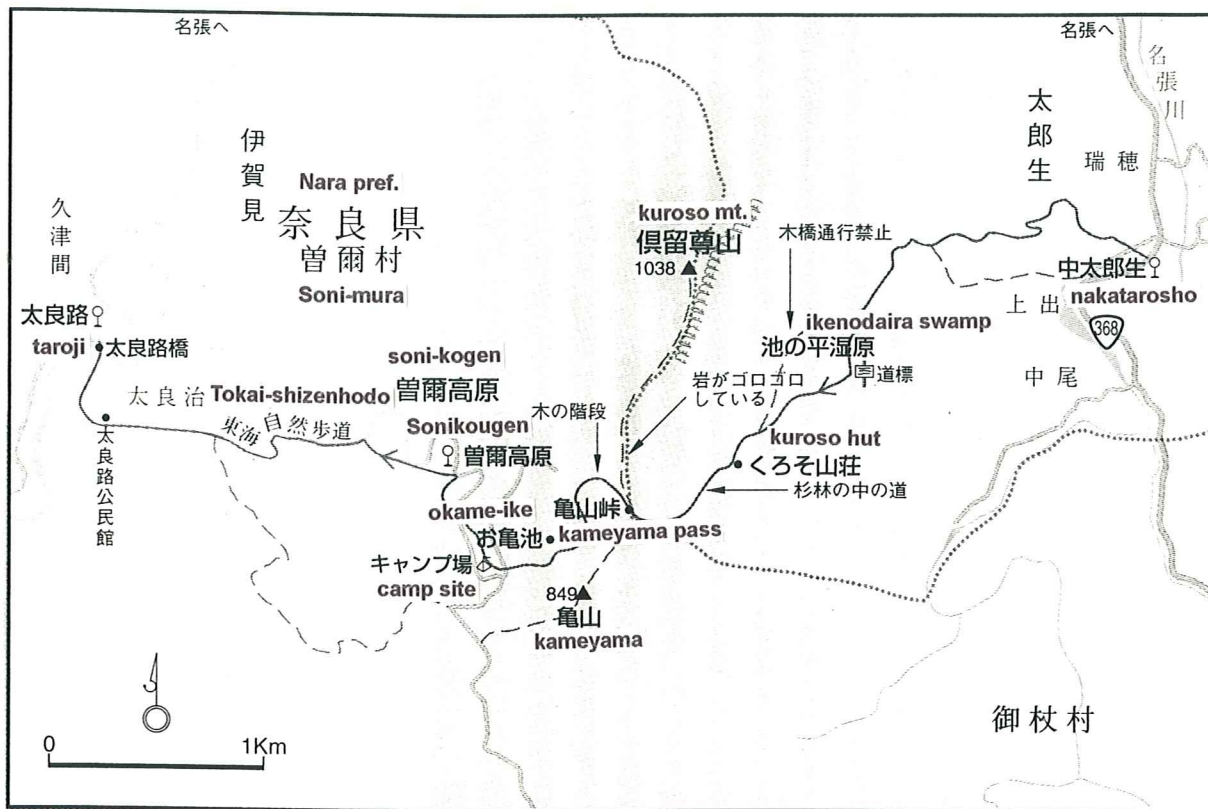

### Vast Plateau Where Various Natural Plants Grow Gregariously

This plateau spreads over the border between Nara and Mie Prefectures, and you can find Mt. Kameyama (1037m) and the Kurosoyama tower at the center of the plateau. The plateau is sometimes called a treasure-house of plants, and you will be able to enjoy the view as it changes from season to season.

For family parties, the route from Nakataro to Tarōji through Kameyama Pass is recommended.

Walk for a while following the signpost at the junction where Nakataro and Kamitaro meet, and you will reach the Kuroso cottage with its triangular roof. The road to the Kameyama Pass is surrounded with thick Japanese cedars and is only dimly lit.

The panoramic view from the Kameyama Pass is excellent. Descend the pass to Okame pond, which is thickly covered with Japanese pampas grass and colored silver in autumn.

When returning home, take the bus for Nabari, from the window of which you can get a nice view of Kochidani, the last but not the least of the views along the route.

### Kurosoyama

Mt. Kurosoyama, with its rocky surface, stands near the Kameyama Pass. It is about a 1 hour and 20 minute walk from the Kameyama Pass to the summit and back. When climbing, there is a fee of ¥500 for adults.

**[Access]** It takes about an hour and a half to Kintetsu Nabari station from Kintetsu Nagoya Station. Then take the Mie Kotsu Bus to Nakataro (50 min)

**[Return]** Take a Mie Kotsu Bus from Tarōji to Nabari (40 min) and then the Kintetsu express to Nagoya (30 min)

**[Fare]** ¥3450.-
