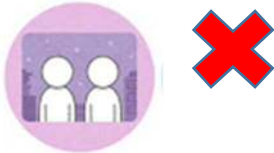


Please be careful not to be infected with the novel coronavirus disease!

Try to avoid the Three "Cs"

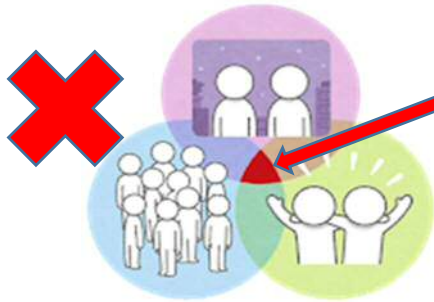
① "Closed space",

② "Crowded places",
where many people
gather



③ "Conversation up
close", where people
talk at a close
distance



When the Three "Cs" are
combined, there is a high risk of
a cluster !

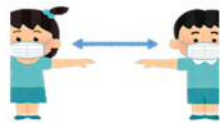
※In addition, please sterilize objects that are
shared.

Apart from indoor spaces, be careful with agglomeration
and close contact even if it is an open air space.

Please wear a mask



Keep sufficient distance from others
(if possible 2 meters)



Please avoid handshakes and hugs

number of people

Please ventilate often, opening
windows and doors

online

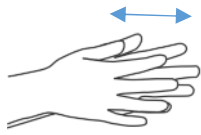


Please talk less on trains and elevators

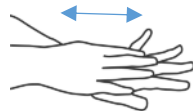


Please wash hands and sterilize hands and fingers frequently

Correct way of washing hands



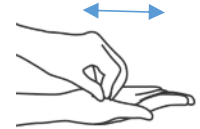
① Wash the palms with soap



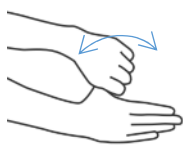
② Wash the backs of the hands



③ Wash in between the fingers



④ Wash the fingertips



⑤ Wash the thumbs



⑥ Wash the wrists



⑦ After rinsing the soap with water, dry well with a towel
