

Applying to the City of Nagoya for the Special Cash Payment (100,000 Yen)

As part of measures to mitigate the economic impact of COVID-19, the Japanese government will be providing 100,000 Yen per person to every person residing in Japan. To be eligible to receive the 100,000 Yen payment, one must have been registered with the Basic Resident Registration System as of April 27, 2020. Foreign nationals can also receive the special cash payment.

How to apply / When to apply:

- **Online applications:** From May 9 (if you have a [My Number Card](#))
- **Postal applications:** From late May, the City of Nagoya will send application forms to each household, addressed to the head of the household. Please complete the application form and return it by post.

Deadline for applications:

Tuesday, September 1, 2020

Distribution of payments:

From June.

Payments will be deposited in the bank account designated by applicants on the application form.
