How to read the chart

[Designated Emergency Assembly Point]

You can evacuate to facilities marked with a circle (○) in the "Designated Emergency Assembly Point" column. (You cannot evacuate to facilities marked with a cross "×" as they are expected to incur damage.)

[Designated Evacuation Shelter]

You can use facilities marked with a circle (○) in the "Designated Evacuation Shelter" column. (You cannot use facilities marked with a cross "×" as a Designated Evacuation Shelter.)

River and Inland Flood
Facilities with "Floor and above" mean that you can evacuate to the floor number and above. (Example: "2nd floor and above" means that you can evacuate to the facilities 2nd floor and above.)

Designated Evacuation Shelter
After the disaster subsides, a place to temporarily evacuate to when your home is damaged and unusable.

1 Indoor Facilities	Designated Emergency Assembly Point	A place to initially evacuate to in order to protect yourself from danger.
2 Outdoor Facilities	Designated Evacuation Shelter	A place to temporarily evacuate to when your home is damaged and unusable.
Designated Emergency Evacuation Shelter	Designated Emergency Evacuation Shelter and Designated Evacuation Shelters outside of ward	Designated Emergency Evacuation Shelters and Designated Evacuation Shelters outside of ward.
Designated Evacuation Shelter	Designated Emergency Assembly Point for Earthquakes and Widespread fire	Designated Emergency Assembly Point for Earthquakes and Widespread fire; parks and open spaces to protect you from disastrous fires.
Designated Evacuation Shelter	Designated Emergency Assembly Point for Earthquakes	Designated Emergency Assembly Point for earthquakes; a place to temporarily evacuate to and access the situation.

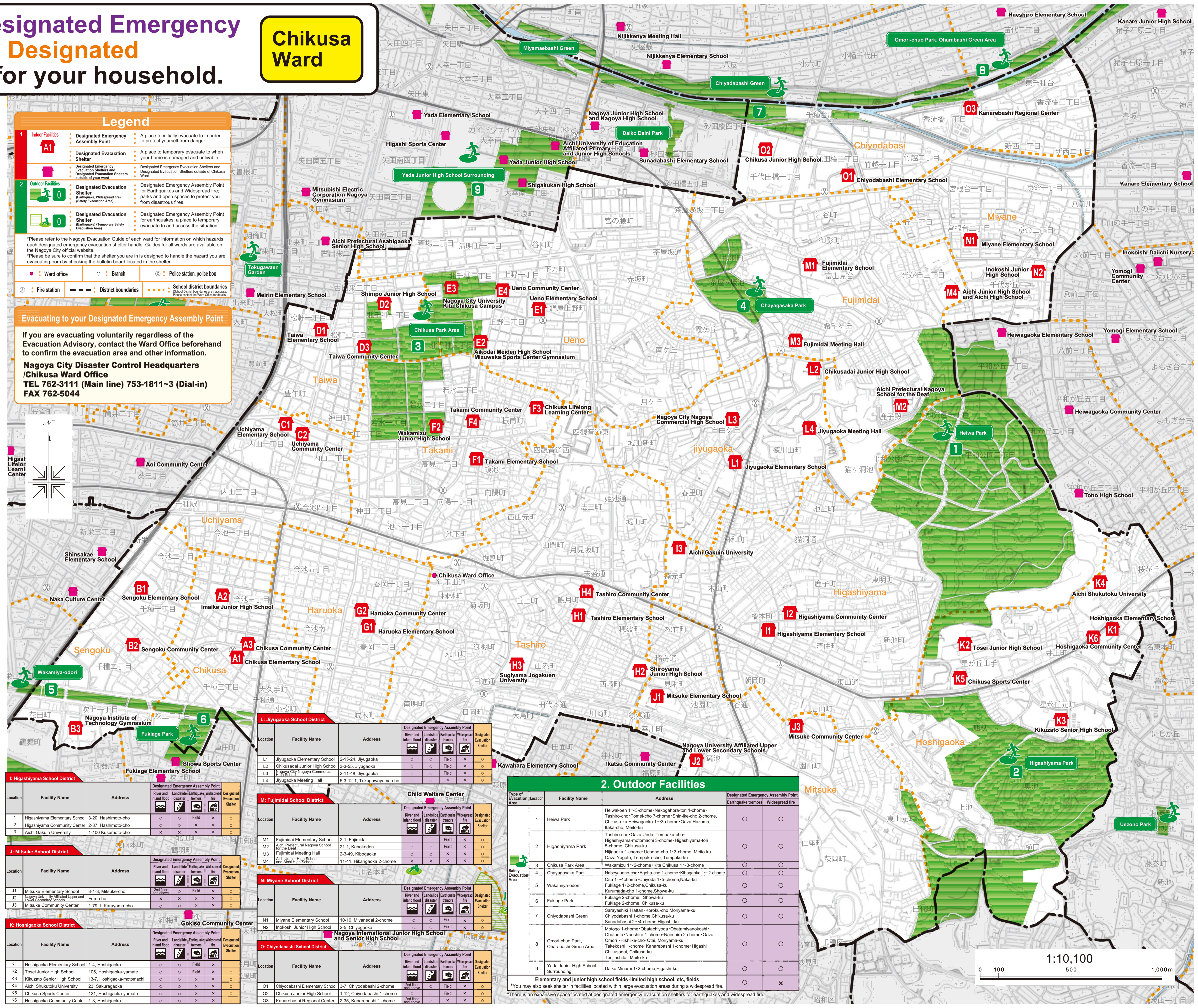
