How to read the chart

[Designated Emergency Assembly Point]

You can evacuate to facilities marked with a circle (○) in the "Designated Emergency Assembly Point" column. (You cannot evacuate to facilities marked with a cross "x" as they are expected to incur damage.)

[Designated Evacuation Shelter]

You can use facilities marked with a circle (○) in the "Designated Evacuation Shelter" column. (You cannot use facilities marked with a cross "x" as a Designated Evacuation Shelter.)

Designated Evacuation Shelter
After the danger subsides, a place to temporarily evacuate to when your home is damaged and uninhabitable.

Earthquake tremors - Widespread fire
If earthquake tremors or widespread fires occur in safe areas, locations that are safe for shelter will be displayed.

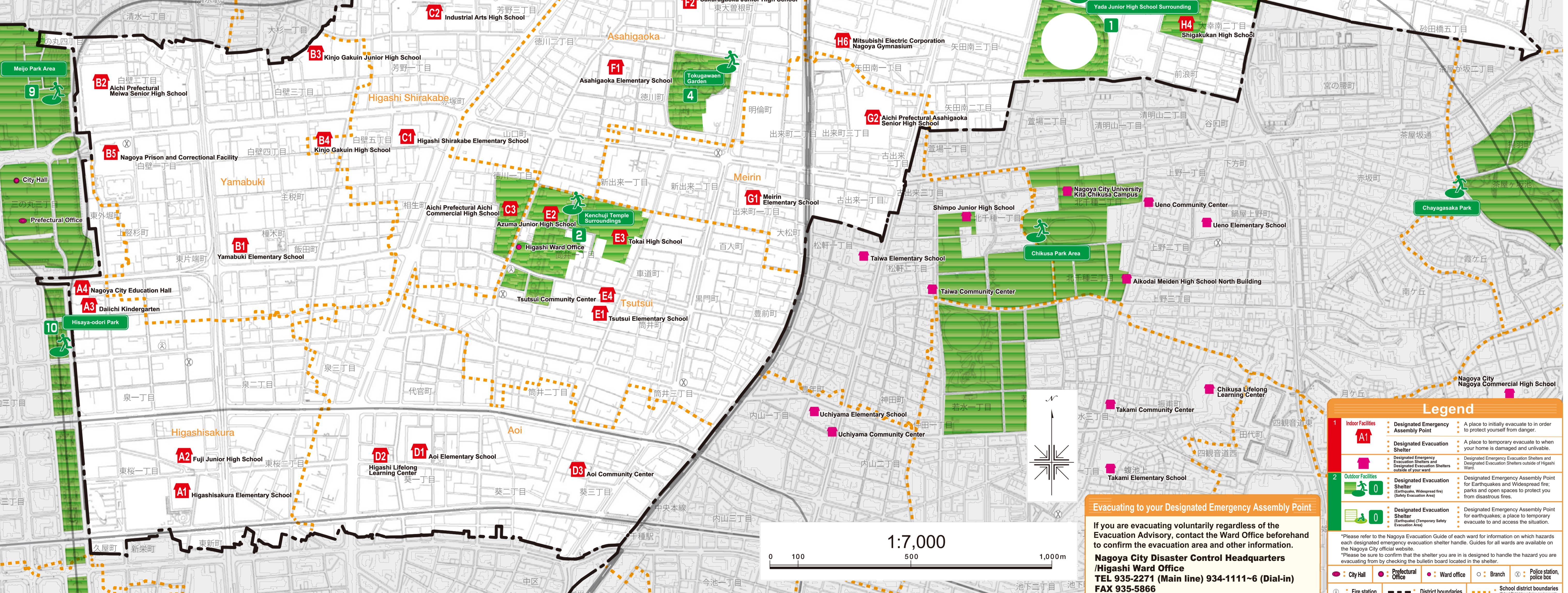

 - Green circle with '0': Designated Evacuation Shelter (Earthquake, Widespread fire) (Safety Evacuation Area)
 - Green circle with '0': Designated Emergency Assembly Point for earthquakes and Widespread fire; parks and open spaces to protect you from disastrous fires.
 - Green circle with '0': Designated Evacuation Shelter (Earthquake) (Temporary Safety Evacuation Area)
 - Green circle with '0': Designated Emergency Assembly Point for earthquakes; a place to temporarily evacuate to and access the situation.
