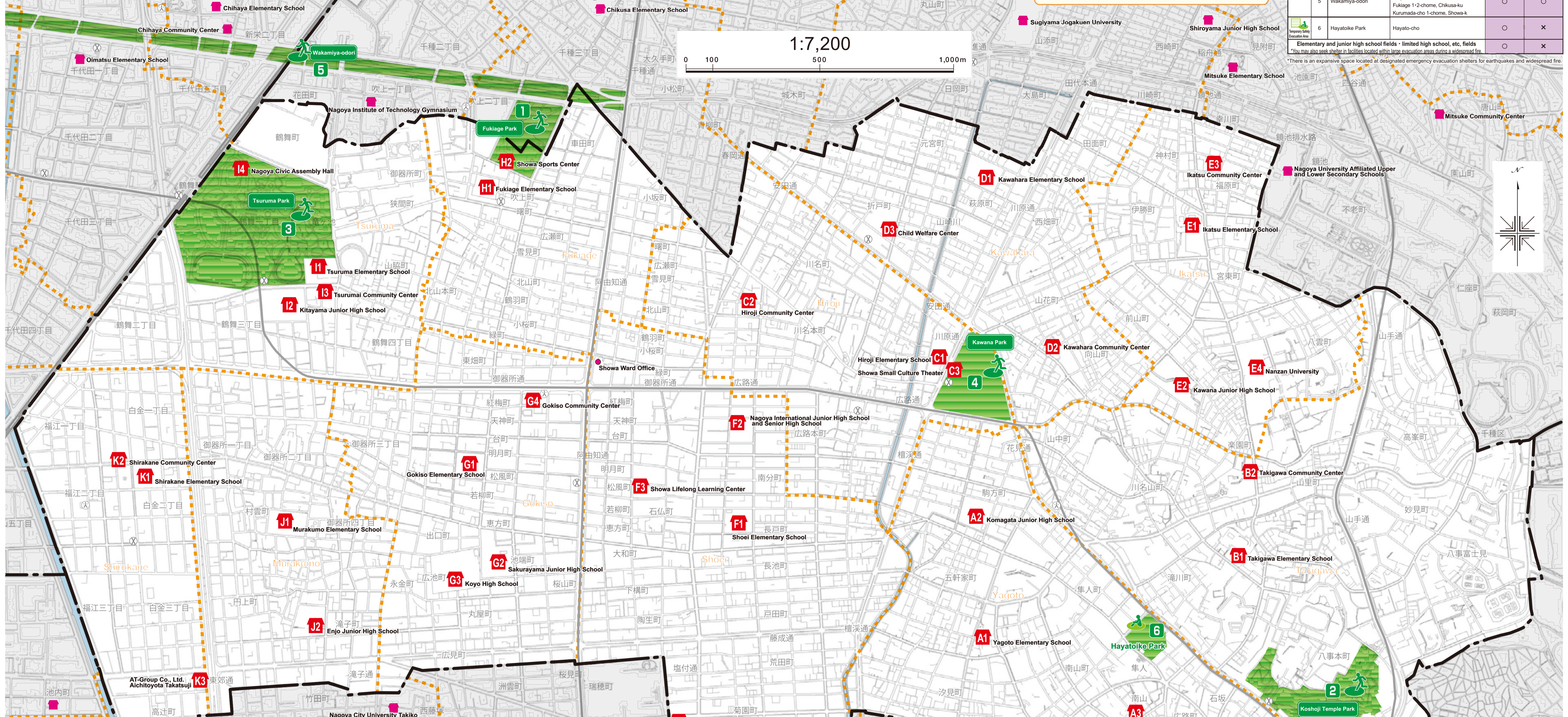

## How to read the chart

### [Designated Emergency Assembly Point]

You can evacuate to facilities marked with a circle (○) in the "Designated Emergency Assembly Point" column. (You cannot evacuate to facilities marked with a cross "x" as they are expected to incur damage.)

### [Designated Evacuation Shelter]

You can use facilities marked with a circle (○) in the "Designated Evacuation Shelter" column. (You cannot use facilities marked with a cross "x" as a Designated Evacuation Shelter.)

**Legend for symbols:**  
 - River and inland flood: Facilities with "floor and above" mean that you can evacuate to the floor number and above. (Example: "2nd floor and above" means that you can evacuate to the facilities 2nd floor and above.)  
 - Landslide disaster: These facilities are outside of the potential landslide area. Evacuation areas are specified for facilities that are partially included in the potential landslide area.  
 - Earthquake tremors: Earthquake tremors or widespread fires occur in safe areas, locations that are safe for shelter will be disrupted.  
 - Designated Evacuation Shelter: After the danger subsides, a place to temporarily evacuate to when your home is damaged and uninhabitable.

- A place to initially evacuate to in order to protect yourself from danger.
- A place to temporarily evacuate to when your home is damaged and uninhabitable.

 \*Please be sure to confirm that the shelter you are in is designed to handle the hazard you are evacuating from by checking the bulletin board located in the shelter.
