Tempaku Ward

How to read the chart

[Designated Emergency Assembly Point]

You can evacuate to facilities marked with a circle (○) in the "Designated Emergency Assembly Point" column. (You cannot evacuate to facilities marked with a cross "x" as they are expected to incur damage.)

[Designated Evacuation Shelter]

You can use facilities marked with a circle (○) in the "Designated Evacuation Shelter" column. (You cannot use facilities marked with a cross "x" as a Designated Evacuation Shelter.)

River and inland flood
Facilities with "2nd floor and above" mean that you can evacuate to the 2nd floor and above. (Example: "2nd floor and above" means that you can evacuate to the 2nd floor and above.)

Designated Evacuation Shelter
After the danger subsides, a place to temporarily evacuate to when your home is damaged and uninhabitable.

Designated Emergency Assembly Point
You can evacuate to facilities marked with a circle (○) in the "Designated Emergency Assembly Point" column. (You cannot evacuate to facilities marked with a cross "x" as they are expected to incur damage.)

Landslide Disaster
These facilities are outside of the potential landslide area. Evacuation areas are specified for facilities that are partially included in the potential landslide area.

Earthquake tremors
If earthquake tremors or widespread fires occur in safe areas, locations that are safe for shelter will be displayed.

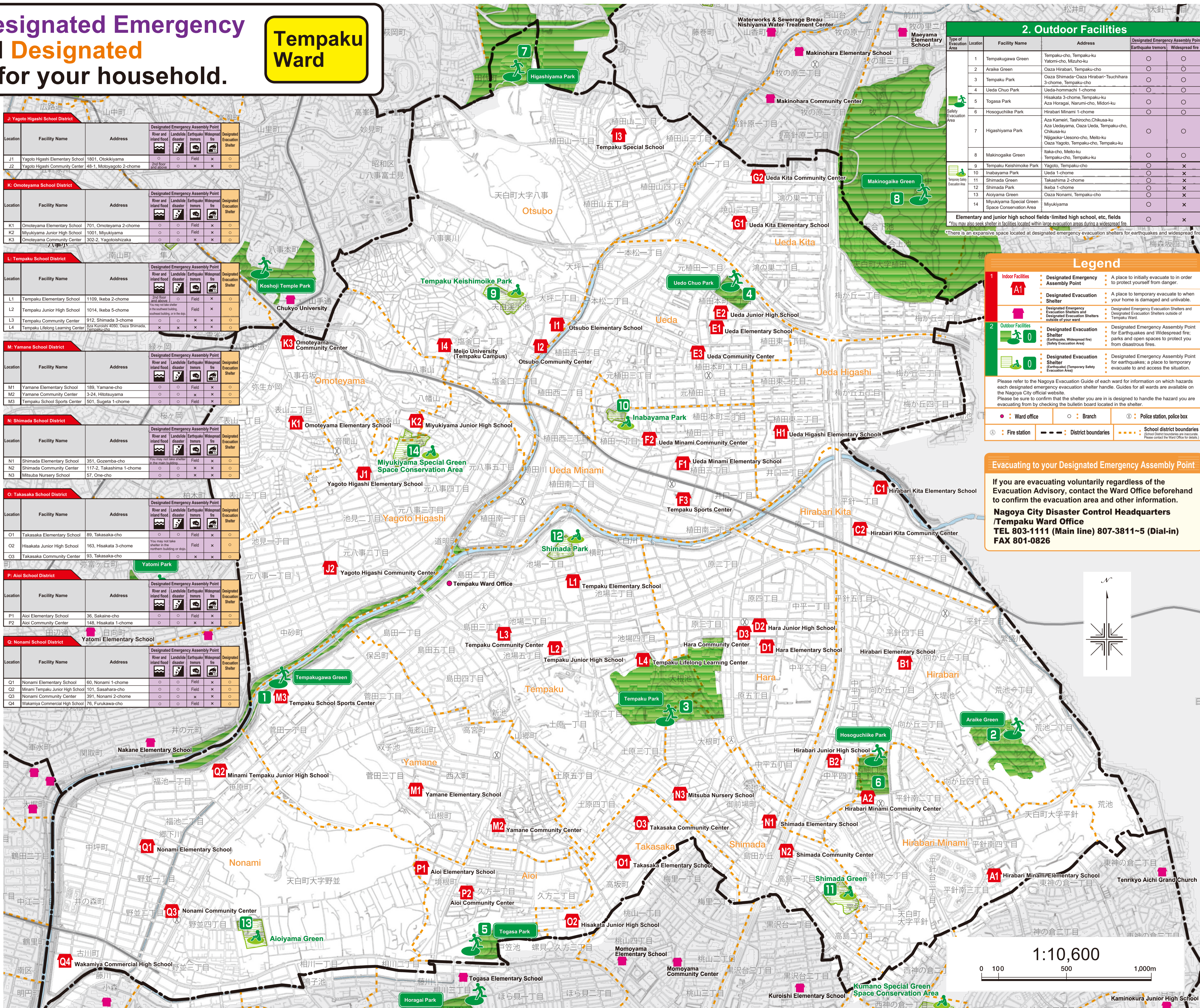
