


NIC Japanese Class for Children



☞ With the aim of providing the Japanese language skills necessary for school and daily life, Nagoya International Center (NIC) volunteer will host Japanese lessons for children whose mother tongue is not Japanese. ☞

Participants:	<p>Children to whom either of the following are applicable:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Children aged between 6 and 15 years old (born between April 2, 2010 and April 1, 2019) whose mother tongue is not Japanese. 2. Junior high school students who were born before April 2, 2010, whose mother tongue is not Japanese, EXCEPT students of junior high school evening classes. (Please apply to the NIC Japanese Class for High School Students, if you currently attend junior high school evening classes.) <p><u>※Priority will be given to those who live in Nagoya City and attend or plan to attend a public elementary school or junior high school in Nagoya City.</u></p>
Lesson Schedule:	From 10:00 to 11:30, every Sunday from September 21 to November 23, 2025
Lesson Location:	Nagoya International Center 3F Lecture Rooms, 5F Conference Room
Participation Fee:	<p>1000 Yen – covers all 10 lessons</p> <p>※The participation fee is non-refundable under any circumstances.</p>
Capacity:	<p>50 places (Lot drawing)</p> <p>※20 places for 1st to 3rd graders in elementary school, 10 places for 4th to 6th graders in elementary school, and 20 places for junior high school students.</p> <p> <u>The application method has changed from a first-come, first-served basis to a lot drawing. Even if you apply early, there will be a lot drawing when there are more applications than places available, and it may not be possible for you to attend the class.</u></p>
Application:	Applications for the class are only accepted online through this website.
Procedure:	<p>Apply via the NIC website between 10:00 Wed. 20 August to 12:00 Fri.29 August, 2025.</p> <p>※Be sure to apply within the application period.</p> <p>※If the maximum capacity is reached, there will be a lot drawing.</p> <p>Siblings who apply together may not necessarily be able to take classes together.</p> <p>※Only one application can be submitted per person. If you submit multiple applications, all your applications will be deemed invalid.</p>
Interview :	<p>Sun. September 14, 2025 (from 10:00~) at NIC 4F Exhibition Room 3)</p> <p>*If you do not come to the Nagoya International Center for the interview and payment, you will not be able to attend the classes.</p> <p>*Children must be accompanied by a parent or guardian during the interview and payment.</p> <p>.....</p> <p>※Parent / guardian must complete the application form with the student.</p> <p>※Please contact us if you are unable to apply online.</p>

- ☆ Classes may be cancelled in the case of a storm warning being issued. In the event of cancellation, Nagoya International Centre will notify participants by e-mail.

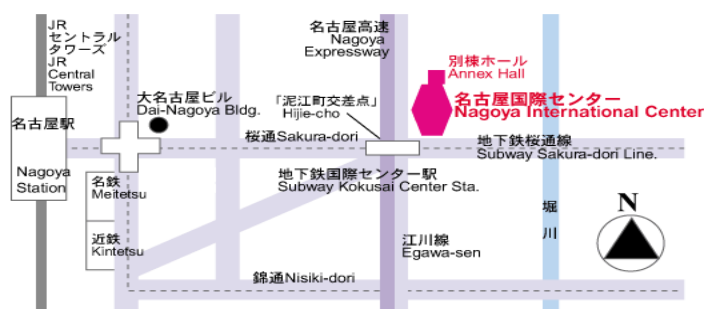
