Japanese Class for Children During Summer Vacation



The Nagoya International Center (NIC) will be providing Japanese lessons during this year's summer vacation for children aged between 6 & 15, whose mother tongue is not Japanese. Volunteers will teach children the Japanese language necessary for school & daily life.

- Participants:** Children to whom either of the following are applicable :
- ① Children aged between 6 and 15 years old (born between April 2, 2007 and April 1, 2016) whose mother tongue is not Japanese.
 - ② Junior high school students who were born before April 2, 2007, whose mother tongue is not Japanese, EXCEPT students of junior high school evening classes. (Please apply to the NIC Japanese Class for High School Students, if you currently attend junior high school evening classes.)
- ※ Preference will be given to those residing in Nagoya City and attending public elementary school or junior high school.

Lesson Schedule: Every Wednesday and Sunday from July 24 to August 31
10:00~11:30 (10 lessons) * No class August 14, 21

Lesson Location: Nagoya International Center 3F, Lecture Room 1,2 and 5F, Japanese Style Rooms

Participation Fee 1000 Yen – covers all 10 lessons **Capacity:** 40 (First come, first served)

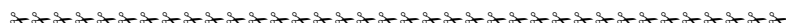


Depending on the situation of the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19), changes may be made to how classes will be held. Please check our website for the latest information.

As part of measures to prevent the spread of COVID-19 infection, participants are requested to observe the following.

- 1) Please wash your hands and gargle. Please wear a mask in the classroom.
- 2) Please do not participate if, during the past two weeks, you have seen a doctor or have been taking medicine for fever or other cold- or flu-like symptoms, or you have travelled overseas (or come into contact with someone who has returned from overseas).
- 3) Before coming to class, please check your temperature at home. If you have a fever (a temperature of 37.5°C or higher, or your temperature is 1°C higher than usual), or other symptoms such as difficulty breathing, a sore throat, a cough, fatigue, etc., please do not participate.
- 4) Please refrain from conversing loudly, eating and drinking (drinking to keep yourself hydrated is welcome) in the classroom and shared indoor spaces, and other behavior that increases the risk of infection.
- 5) When entering the classroom, please allow staff to take your temperature, and provide your contact details. If a case of infection occurs, this information will be used to trace contacts.
- 6) If a case of infection occurs, please cooperate with health center efforts to trace contacts. If you are identified as a high-risk contact, please follow instructions issued by the health center.

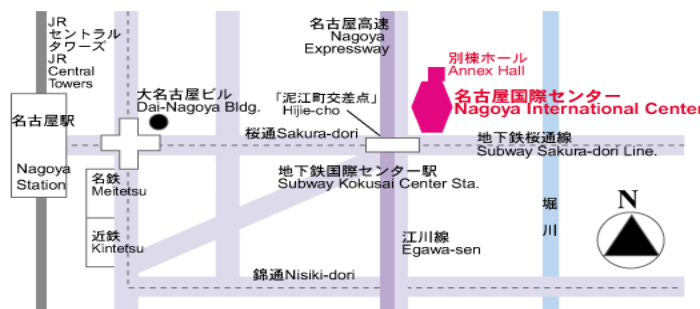

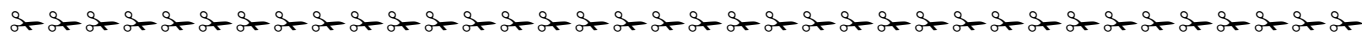
